Anti-Doping Policy

Definitions

1. The following term has this meaning in this Policy:
 - a) “*Individuals*” – All categories of membership defined in the Dive Ontario Bylaws, as well as all individuals employed by, or engaged in activities with, Dive Ontario including, but not limited to, athletes, coaches, judges, officials, volunteers, managers, administrators, committee members, spectators, parents/guardians and directors and officers of Dive Ontario.

Application

2. This Policy applies to all Individuals.

Adoption

3. Dive Ontario opposes the practice of doping in sport and has adopted the 2015 Canadian Anti-Doping Program (CADP) as its primary domestic anti-doping policy. Administered by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES), the 2015 CADP is fully compliant with the 2015 World Anti-Doping Code, International Standards and Guidelines as they may exist from time to time. 4. Dive Ontario does not develop independent policies on doping, choosing rather to accept and adopt the 2015 CADP.

Penalties/Sanctions

5. Dive Ontario will respect any penalty enacted pursuant to a breach of the 2015 CADP and are not appealable under Dive Ontario's Appeal Policy.
