Strategic Plan

Board Structure did not match Strat Plan

- Changed roles as a pilot structure
- Evaluated pilot structure
- Survey came back positive
- Board will remain at 6 members

Executive Director stepped down mid-season

Full recruiting process introduced

Difficulties in getting volunteers together for interview process

Board was extremely operational

Therefore – not a whole lot of progress made

Had to host meet's and hire personnel to help

Summer Games had to happen

Strategic Initiatives did not move forward

Review of the Strat Plan to 2020 – decisions must be steered by data.

Some strategic plan targets are for 2024

Instituted flat rate for Club Registration

Ministry changed funding model to include past grants

Grants were imbedded in Base Grant

Meet Manager role introduced.

4 years ago – Dive Ontario started running Meets which became the Executive Director's function Sport and Tourism wants Dive Ontario to develop a more "Technical Role"

Junior Development Creation of Aspire Level Ontario Summer Games Team Ontario Recognition Awards Night HP pathway – OHPSI

Athlete Accomplishments – Peter presented 2017/18 results

4. Financial Presentation - Pat Grobe

Pat presented 2018 actuals and 2019 Budget

 Flat rate for Club Registration helped with the reserve \$211K – budget was \$209K

There were courses still being run on the last day of the fiscal year – therefore clinic numbers are a little skewed but still within \$2000 of revenue target.

Expenses

- Executive director salary presented savings
- DO hosted Jr. Nationals @ TPASC was a huge loss, budget was \$10K actual was \$20K
- DO was under the assumption that they could apply for a grant to host
- Event was excellent BUT will never host again
- Sport Business budget was not spent
- Initiatives were presented but could not decide
- New Coop Marketing Grant presented to Clubs
- Sport Business budget deferred to this season
- \$23 surplus due to savings on Exec Dir. Salary

2019

- Flat rate registration Revenues easy to predict
- OHPSI funding to be reduced from \$37K to \$25K
- Revenues to drop about \$20K
- Sport Business larger because of carry-over
- DO to reinvest these overages
- Sport Performance = \$12,500
- Introduction of Ontario First program 3 years ago, TBDC to receive grant because could not use Winnipeg as a qualifier for Q4G.
- Officials budget is \$14000 annually
- Administration = Meet Manager and Executive Director Salaries
- Predicting \$16000 deficit

Motion from Pat Grobe to accept the Financials as presented.

2nd Brian Dixon All in Favor Motion passed.

Motion from Pat Grobe to appoint BDO as 2018/19 auditors.

2nd Luda Zakharenko All in Favor Motion passed.

5. New Board Structure Presented by Peter Voros.

Motion to accept Bylaw #6 (roles and board structure)

1st Jason Napper 2nd Luda Zakharenko All in favor. Motion passed.

Question from the floor (Brian Dixon) about 6 Board members and how do they break ties. President does not vote.

New Board should move to a Governance Board.

6. Ratifications of the Board

Motion to accept the workings of the Dive Ontario Board for the 2017/18 season.

1st Pat Grobe 2nd Brennan Villemaire All in Favor Motion Passed.
