# Rules

All dive sheets are due **24 hours** prior to the event. Download the latest version of the software [here](#).

Make sure to match the divers' age group on both registration form and dive sheet generator.

Dive sheets submitted after these times will be subject to a \$25 late dive sheet fee (as per Diving Canada rulebook).

No new dive sheets will be accepted within one hour of the posted start time of the event.

Changes to the dive sheets must be submitted a minimum of 1 hour prior to the events posted started time.

[Diving Plongeon Canada 2017-2021 rules](#) will apply to all Age Group events.

[Fina 2017-2021 rules](#) apply to the senior events in addition to [Dive Ontario Technical Regulations rule 4.3](#)

Summarized here:

- (i) X01 or X02 dives are **not** allowed on 1M or 3M, where X denotes any group
- (ii) X02 dives are **not** allowed in any Senior Platform event
- (iii) X01 dives shall be performed from the 10M platform **only**
- (iv) Every list entered must have a total DD equal to or greater than the minimum for that event:

Senior Women	10.8	11.5	12.0
Senior Men	13.0	14.8	14.2
