Assists in all learn to dive and supplementary programs, assesses success of programs and makes recommendations to move the program forward successfully.

- Helps in reviewing current programs, and suggests amendments if needed to modify curriculum as needed.
- Ensures effective coaching coverage at all times.
- Performs other related duties including equipment maintenance, etc., as assigned by Head Coach.

- National Coaching Certification Program – Competitive Introduction Trained as a Diving Coach, certification an asset.
- 4-6 years related experience.
- Skills to assess program information, and to make recommendations for future programming.
- 2-year diploma in a related field (e.g. sport team management, business management, kinesiology), is an asset.
