General Description: Technical Director

The Technical Director (TD) reports to the Executive Director (ED) and will work collaboratively with the ED, the DO Board of Directors and Board Committees as the technical lead for the organization.

The TD will work effectively with our partners at Diving Plongeon Canada (DPC) and The Canadian Sport Institute of Ontario (CSIO), as well collaborate with the DO VP Sports Performance, Executive Director, all Member Clubs, and other stakeholders within the Diving community.

This position is a 1-year PT (15-30 hours/week, will vary) contract. Dive Ontario's ultimate goal is to create a permanent TD position.

The immediate priority will be to take responsibility for the DO's High Performance program. In the first 90 days the focus will be to

- Prepare and communicate the plan of action to return to the Ontario High Performance Sport Initiative Category 2 Sport level.
- Develop, analyze and track criteria to select Ontario High Performance Sport Initiative (OHPSI) Athletes.
- Develop, analyze and track data for the provincial Gold Medal Profiling (GMP).
- Develop, analyze and run training camps for selected high-performance athletes in Ontario.

Going forward the TD will

- Execute on the plan to return to the Ontario High Performance Sport Initiative Category 2 Sport level.
- Provide technical leadership and expertise for clubs across the province to improve their training environments.
- Develop, analyze and track an Ontario Diving Podium Pathway and High-performance Pathway.
- Develop, analyze and track a Coaches Professional Development pathway.

- Develop, analyze and track Sport Sciences and Sport Med. (Physio, Nutrition, Conditioning, Psychology, ...) for selected athletes and/or clubs
- Develop, Analyze and track a High-Performance vision as well as a Technical Planning for selected athletes.

The TD's input will be needed to ensure the DO Board has the right set of priorities to develop the sport of diving in Ontario.
