# Provincial Ministry of Sport Quest for Gold 2022 Funding Criteria SUMMARY

### Q4G 2022 – Unique Situation this year only

- Government funds have been given to Dive Ontario for selection criteria and administration of disbursement (not the Q4G committee themselves as is normally done)
- Selection and Fund disbursement must be completed by May 31, 2022
- Divers must be NON-carded at National level, and between age 11 22
- Due to lack of data points over past 2 years due to covid-19 pandemic, new criteria for this 1-time disbursement has been set through the collaborative efforts and agreement across:
  - Dive Ontario VP Finance and VP Members
  - Sport Performance Committee
  - Quest for Gold Committee

## Q4G 2022 – Selection Criteria for funding

- 10 divers (5 boys, 5 girls) will be selected to receive funding available: \$3,559 each
- Selection criteria is based on the single best results from Provincial NQ competitions this season:

Winter\* (London Dec 2021) Spring (TPASC March 2022) Summer (Windsor May 2022)

#### **IMPORTANT NOTE:** BOTH Open and Age Group , 3M and Platform, event results will be used in the calculations

The selection criteria has 2 components, equally weighted:

- 1. The athlete's single best result from any **open event** (Platform or 3m) at any of the provincials: Event Score will be divided by the applicable Quest for Gold standard and multiplied by 100 to get a percentage
- 2. The athlete's single best result from any **age group event** (Platform or 3m) at any of the provincials: Event score will be divided by the applicable Junior PanAm International Standard and multiplied by 100 to get a percentage

These two components will be added together to assign the athlete a total score, rounded to two decimal places (ties will go to 3 decimals). The athletes will then be ranked according to their total scores. The top five girls and top five boys will be awarded funding.

Note: 'single best result' is going to be where the athlete was closest to the standard or exceeded it to the greatest extent. It will not necessarily be the "highest total score" or their best position in the overall rankings for a particular event.

\*Winter Provincials will consider Open, A, and B events only - as C's did not have Finals
