1 Selection Criteria

1.1 Team Size: 8

- 4 male athletes
- 4 female athletes

1.2 Coaches: 2

- 1 male coach
- 1 female coach

1.3 Manager: 1

- Male or Female

1.4 Athlete Eligibility

- Athletes date of birth must be between 2006-2013.
- Athletes must meet all Canada Games Eligibility requirements.
- Athletes who are on the Sr. National Team are not eligible, unless granted an exemption by DPC.

1.5 Selection Process will consist of the following steps:

- Selection Process:
 - The selection will be based on results from the open events at 2025 Ontario Summer Provincials.
 - For each gender, the Ontario athlete with the highest score on each event (1m, 3m, Platform) will automatically be selected.
 - Where spots remain open, the divers who achieve the highest combined scores from the 1m, 3m & platform events will be selected.
 - An alternate diver per gender will also be named. The alternate will travel and compete in the Games only in the case of illness or injury of one of the Team Members prior to registration deadline.
 - The alternate will be the diver who achieves the highest combined score on 1m, 3m, & platform events.
- Team Announcement:
 - The Team will be announced within one week after the 2025 Ontario Summer Provincial Championship.

1.6 Resolutions of Ties

- In the case of a tie for first place
 - In the case of a tie on 3m or platform events both divers will be selected.



- In the case of a tie on the 1m event the diver with the highest cumulative score on all 3 events will be selected.
- In the case of a cumulative score tie
 - In the case of a cumulative score tie the diver with the highest percentage compared to the senior national score 2025 on 3m or platform will be selected.

1.7 Coach Eligibility:

- All Coaches must meet Canada Games eligibility requirements by April 30th, 2025
- Coach Certification:
 - Head Coach must be at least Competition Development Certified.
 - Assistant Coach must be at least Competition Development Trained.

1.8 Coach Selection Criteria:

- Coaches receive 1 point for each athlete selected to the team.
- The first spot on the team (Head Coach) is filled with the eligible coach (see “Coach Eligibility”) who received the most points as described above.
- To fill the second spot on the team (Assistant Coach), only eligible coaches (see “Coach Eligibility”) of the gender opposite to that of the previously selected Head Coach will be considered.
- Where there is a tie between coaches, the coach with the highest placing athletes breaks the tie. If there is still a tie, preference will be given to the coach whose best athlete scored a higher absolute score.
- Should a coach be selected to the team and decline to participate, this coach will be eliminated from consideration and the selection process will be conducted again as following the steps outlined above.
