1 Aspire Competitions

1.1 Goals & Vision

The purpose of Aspire competitions is to support diver development, provide meaningful competition opportunities, and prepare athletes for progression to higher levels of competition. These events balance inclusivity with fair competition standards while ensuring athletes are placed in the most appropriate performance pathway.

1.2 Eligibility & Exhibition Criteria

- Divers must compete in their own age group, with the exception of Group E divers, who may compete in either Group E or Group D on each board (but not both).
- Aspire competitions are open to all registered competitive divers in H2O.
- National finalists from the immediate prior season in the same age group (Anyone on OHPSI list) are not eligible to compete in aspire events or exhibition.
- Athletes who achieve a National Qualifying Score (NQS) this season may compete as exhibition at Aspire meets, except at Aspire Provincials.
- Provincials must include 1m, 3m, and Platform (3m, 5m, 7.5m where available). 7.5m optional if the facility lacks a platform.
- Aspire Provincials will include both Aspire I, Aspire II, and Masters events.

1.3 Coach & Instructor Requirements

- All coaches must be listed on the registration package submitted to the host club at least 2 weeks prior to the competition, including their NCCP certification level.
- All instructors who are instructor beginner coaches must list their supervisor on the registration form.
- Any coach, regardless of certification level, who is on deck at a competition must be insured as a coach in H2O.
- Any instructor who will be attending competitions must also be registered as a coach in H2O.

1.4 Diver Registration & Attendance

- A diver's first competition may be covered under recreational insurance.
- After that, all divers must be registered as Competitive Divers with Dive Ontario at least 14 days before any Dive Ontario-sanctioned competition.
- Divers must register for competitions at least 2 weeks prior to the competition start date.
- If a diver registers for an Aspire Meet but achieves a National Qualifying Score (NQS) within the 2-week registration period, the diver becomes ineligible for Aspire and may withdraw without penalty.
- No diver may compete unless supervised by a trained coach registered with Dive Ontario, or otherwise eligible under Diving Plongeon Canada (DPC) rules.

1.4.1 Group D

- Divers who achieve a NQS on 1m only may continue to compete at Aspire.
- Divers who achieve a NQS on 3m or Platform are no longer eligible for Aspire for the remainder of the season.
- They may compete as exhibition at all Aspire meets except Aspire Provincials.

1.6 Rulebook References

Aspire rules follow the framework of Diving Plongeon Canada (DPC) and World Aquatics (WA), but are simplified slightly to help athletes progress toward Diving Canada and international competition standards.

2 Skills Bank

- The skills listed below apply to all age groups in Aspire 1, and Aspire 2 group D
- 7m & 10m skills are not allowed in any age group.

3 Aspire I

3.1 Aspire I General Rules

- For Aspire competitions, age groups (Masters, A, B, C, D, E) will be combined as gender-inclusive events. This means all athletes, regardless of gender, will compete together in the same event.
- For all age groups except E, a valid list may include only skills, only dives, or a mix of both.
- Group E divers must perform either an all-skills list or a mixed list of skills and dives. An all-dives list is not permitted.
- If one dive is performed, the first dive may be from any direction,
 - If two dives are performed, two directions must be competed.
 - If three dives are performed, three directions must be competed.
- If a fourth dive is added, one direction may be repeated.
 - The same goes for the 5th and 6th dive. (minimum 3 directions)
 - When a 7th and 8th dive is introduced one direction may not be repeated more than twice. (I.e. if front, back, and inward have already been added to the list twice, a fourth direction must be introduced, or a skill will be performed)
- Inclusion of dives is optional. (Ex. may compete 100a, 100c, 100b, 200a, 200c, 200b, 001b, 002a as a full list)
- Take-offs may be standing or with hurdle
- Arms up or arm swing permitted on take-off
- Somersaults, doubles, and triples not allowed 5m or higher.
 - With the exception of 404c on 5m.
- Handstands somersault, doubles allowed on all platforms.
- Half twist dives permitted (5111, 5211, 5311, 5411)

4 Aspire II

4.1 Age Group E (9 & under)

- This is not a gender inclusive category. Females and Males will be 2 separate events.
- 4 rounds = 3 compulseries+1 optional
 - 3 rounds from permitted dives list
 - Last round from permitted dives list, or a skill
- Take-offs may be standing or with hurdle
- Arms up or arm swing permitted on take-off
- For jump skills: arms can be up or down on entry
- Somersault skills: arms must be down on entry
- All dives: DD 1.6
- All Skills: DD 1.0
- Lists must cover 3 directions

4.2 General Rules (Age Groups D, C, B & A)

- This is not a gender inclusive category. Females and Males will be 2 separate events.
- **Arm Position:** For any feet-first entry, arms must follow World Aquatics (WA) rules: arms down on entry. <https://www.worldaquatics.com/rules/competition-regulations>
- **Take-Offs:** May be standing or with a hurdle; arms up or arm swing is permitted on take-off.
- **List Requirements:**
 - Lists must cover 4 directions on 3m and platform for all age groups.
 - 1m springboard direction limits vary by age group:
 - D & C: 4 directions
 - B & A: 5 directions
 - No repeating dives
 - Dives may not exceed DD 2.8
- **Feet-First Entries:** Allowed on 1m springboard.
- **Optionals on 3m Platform Dives (WA DD applied):**
 - Permitted dives: 202CBA, 302C, 103B, 104CB, 203C, 204C, 402c, 403C, 5221D, 5122D, 5223D.
 - DD is the same as 1m springboard, except handstand dives, which use the same DD as 5m handstands.
- **"Any Valid Dive"** refers to any dive (head-first or feet-first) listed in the WA DD table, and follows age group specific rules.
 - **Exceptions:**
 - Feet-first entries not allowed on:
 - 3m springboard or 5m platform, except 404c
 - 7m or 10m platforms (no exceptions)
 - Dives 102, 5121, 5111, 5211, 5311, 5411 are not allowed on any board
 - Note: Dive 204 is prohibited on 3m springboard and 5m+ because Dive Ontario does not want to encourage skipping 203, which is considered an integral step in dive progression. 204 allowed on 1m springboard, and 3m platform

4.3 Aspire II – Group D (10-11) Specific Rules

- 5 rounds = 4 dives + 1 Skill, or 5 dives
- First 4 rounds DD 1.6
- Round 5 World Aquatics DD for dive. 1.0DD for skill
- Platform all 5 rounds may be performed on 3m or 5m

4.4 General Rules (Age Groups C, B & A)

- All rounds WA DD
- Platform compulsories not allowed on 3m
 - C&B 5m and 7m only
 - A's 5m, 7m, 10m

4.5 Aspire II – Group C (12-13) Specific Rules

- 6 rounds = 6 dives
 - 1m: 4 compulsories + 2 optionals
 - 3m springboard and platform: 3 compulsories + 3 optionals

4.6 Aspire II – Group B (14-15) Specific Rules

- 1m - 8 rounds: 5 compulsories + 3 optionals
- 3m springboard and platform - 7 rounds: 4 compulsories + 3 optionals

- 1m: 5 compulsories +3 optionals
- Lists must cover 5 directions
- * Dives 102, 5121, 5111, 5211, 5311, 5411 are not allowed
- 204 only allowed on 1m springboard, and 3m platform
